Position Title: PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT - CERTIFIED

Position Description:

The Physician Assistant is responsible for assisting the supervising physician(s) within the supervising physician's normal course of practice to provide quality care for patients and to increase patient access and satisfaction. Standard tasks to be performed by a physician assistant under direct supervision, on-site/off-site supervision, include but are not limited to the following:

- Assess patients in both inpatient and out-patient settings.
- Obtain comprehensive patient histories and perform physical exams.
- Order and perform routine diagnostic procedures.
- Develop and implement treatment plans.
- Order and monitor the effectiveness of therapeutic interventions.
- Provide instruction to meet patient needs.
- Manage patient care with minimal supervision
- Institute and change orders on patient charts as directed by the supervising physician.
- Round with supervising physician in a hospital setting when necessary.
- Take daily or weekend call for supervising physician when necessary.

Position Qualifications/Requirements:

The Physician Assistant must meet the following minimum requirements to be considered for the available Physician Assistant position:

- Education/Expertise:
 - Formal Physician Assistant training from an accredited program with NCCPA certification.
 - At least 2 years experience as a Physician's Assistant, preferably in a pulmonary practice.
 - Must be able to perform the tasks relative to the treatment of pulmonary disease in which the Physician Assistant will practice.
 - Demonstration of quality care in prior positions.
 - An assessment of any claims or litigation against the PA, if applicable.
- Required Credentials, Licensure or Certification:
 - NCCPA-certified PA (PA-C).
 - Must meet all requirements of the Florida State Medical Board for Physician Assistants.
 - Licensure from the State of Florida Health Department as approved by the Florida State Medical Board.
- Special Skills & Equipment Knowledge:
 - Prior experience using computerized EHR to document/chart patient-specific information.
 - Working knowledge of Microsoft Windows and Microsoft Office.
